Supplementary Regulations

Sanction Number 11-R-1683-S

This event is conducted under the 2011 SCCA General Competition Rules and these Supplementary Regulations.

ENTRIES:

1. Entry fee is \$250. Late Entry: Add \$100.00 to the total amount if postmarked after Sept. 6, 2011.
2. Checks returned for any reason will incur a \$30.00 service fee.
3. Registrar is not responsible for any entry sent by a delivery service that requires a daytime signature or special pickup.
4. Drivers must present at registration the ID required by the GCR. The restricted regional race is open to Novice Permit holders, Regional license, National license holders, and all referenced by GCR 3.1.5.
5. **16 and 17 year old drivers** are required to contact Bobbie Hannan at bhannan@midohio.com or 419-884-4000 for copies of Mid-Ohio's **Minor Waiver (this is in addition to the SCCA Minor Waiver)**. These should be obtained well in advance & require a Notary Public's signature. The completed waivers and information must be e-mailed to the address above. **15 Year old drivers NOT allowed by MID-OHIO.**
6. Crew: Entry fee includes one (1) driver and three (3) crew members. Additional crew passes may be purchased for \$10.00 each. Only the entrant, driver, or designee (authorized in writing) may change the crew list.
7. Confirmation postcard or email will be sent only if you don't get your first choice of number. Correct number must be on car prior to tech.
8. Trophy Distribution: by class: 1-2 cars = 1; 3 cars = 2; 4+ cars = 3, plus 1st, 2nd, and 3rd overall. Plus, class winners will receive a checkered flag.
9. **Competitors whose licenses are pending must call the registrar by Sept. 13, 2011, so that the license can be confirmed. \$10 charge for this service.**
10. **This is a Restricted Regional Race** open to the following classes only: SMR, ITS, ITA, ITB, & ITC. SMR is defined as Spec Miata Regional, and includes only Spec Miata's prepared to Spec Miata (SM) rules.

REGISTRATION:

Cancellations will be accepted by mail or phone until 6:00 PM, Sept. 13, 2011, and will receive a refund. Phoned cancellations must be followed up **in writing** to receive a refund. A **\$30 fee** will be collected for cancellations after Sept. 13, 2011. No refund for "no shows" or because of weather. Cancellations on entries paid through motorsportsreg.com will have a 4.5% (9% if refund by credit card) deduction to cover msr.com online fees.

1. **Minor Waivers: Single event waivers may be signed by one parent/legal guardian. Signatures must be witnessed by a notary (only on form MS2A), a licensed SCCA Registrar, or a Steward. Persons other than a parent/legal guardian may NOT sign Minor Waivers. Annual Minor Waivers (yellow Photo ID) must be signed by two parents/legal guardians and will cost \$5.**

CONDUCT OF THE EVENT:

1. The **first 3 finishers in class** will report to impound at the Tech Building immediately following the last (trophy) race, or podium ceremony..
2. **Operational AMB TranX260 transponders are mandatory for this race.** The location of the test loop is the Tech Inspection area, and it will be staffed the same hours as the Scales.
3. Sound control will not be enforced for this event:
4. There will be no waived Tech at this event. If you have an Annual Tech and a current 2011 SCCA helmet sticker (blue), you need only present your logbook & Tech Sheet at Tech.
5. No radios will be permitted which interfere with track communications, 151.625, 151.805, and 154.600.
6. 1 Race Group (5 Regional classes). The Pro Course track length is 2.38 miles; per GCR 6.4.1.B, maximum of 66 cars per group
7. The following classes (only) are eligible for this event: ITS, ITA, ITB, ITC, SMR (SMR is Spec Miata Regional and has the same preparation rules as Spec Miata).
8. The Friday session will be timed practice only. Time sheets will be available at Information under the Tower. Saturday's session will be qualifying for the first race on Sunday.
9. On Sunday, the first race will be 13 laps with starting position based on Saturday qualifying (a non-trophy qualifying race with no impound). The second race will be a 15 lap qualifying race with starting position based on finishing position of race #1 (a non-trophy qualifying race with no impound). The third race will be a trophy race for 19 laps with starting position based on finishing position of race #2 (first 3 finishers in each class go to impound)..
10. The Black Flag reporting area is in the area of the base of the start/finish stand on pit lane.
11. The **PADDOCK** will be marked for SCCA, and will be in the upper grassy area; this is the only place you may paddock.
12. **THERE WILL BE A MANDATORY DRIVERS MEETING IN THE PADDOCK AT 5:00 PM ON FRIDAY!**

Paddock speed limit is 10 MPH. Anyone operating ANY motorized vehicle on the track property must have a valid driver's license (any state) and present it to any official upon request. **Bicycles, skates, Razors, scooters, & skateboards (with or w/o motor) are banned.** Unlicensed motor scooters, motorcycles, ATV's, etc. cannot leave the Paddock except to go to the Grid or Showers. Golf carts need a Mid-Ohio permit.

1. Fuel spillage on any paved area of the facility is forbidden and may result in a black flag and liability for repairs if instructions from any officials are not obeyed promptly. Jack stand bases must be supported so as to avoid pavement indentations
2. No unmuffled engines may be operated between 7 PM and 7 AM **unless traveling to or from Tech on Thurs evening.**
3. Minimum age in the pits is 18 years. Shirts, long pants, and closed shoes are required in the pits. Credentials must be clearly visible at all times.
4. Camping will be permitted on Thursday, Friday and Saturday nights only. The camping area is limited to the paddock. **Motor homes will be free if parked in the grass paddock with your race car. No camping tents in the Paddock; you must use the camping area designated.**
5. **THIS IS A SPECTATOR EVENT**, so the entire spectator viewing areas will be open. Please respect Mid-Ohio and dispose of trash correctly.
6. **No pets** are permitted on track property. **No exceptions.**
7. Sale of any products on Mid-Ohio property is strictly prohibited without prior written permission from Mid-Ohio and OVR-SCCA, Inc. Contact Mary Weir @ 614-793-4613.
8. Please use the provided receptacles for trash, oil, and other fluids. Do not leave any tires at the track, except with tire vendors.
9. You will be required to vacate the premises by 10:00 PM Sunday. If later, you will be billed for the cost of Security.
